

Bamboo is a biobased, biodegradable alternative to fossil-fuel based materials (such as the most common forms of plastic). Due to a broad range of benefits, Bamboo is widely recognised as a more environmentally conscious alternative to your standard plastic and wooden options.



Eco Credentials

- Bamboo is biodegradable and renewable (absorbing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and replacing it with oxygen).
- Bamboo self regenerates from its own roots without the need for synthetic fertilisers (improving soil quality as it grows).
- Bamboo is naturally pest resistant (meaning pesticides aren't needed).
- Bamboo requires far less water to grow than most similar crops (e.g. cotton).
- Bamboo is believed to possess antibacterial and antifungal properties.
- Most Bamboo products are suitable for dying with natural/vegetable-based dyes.
