Due to a broad range of benefits, Basswood is widely recognised as a more environmentally conscious alternative to your standard plastic and wooden options.

- Basswood is recyclable, biodegradable and renewable (absorbing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and replacing it with oxygen).
- Basswood from sustainably managed forests is grown faster than it is consumed.*
- Basswood is grown without the need for synthetic fertilisers (improving soil quality as it grows).
- Basswood is believed to be **hypoallergenic**.
- Most Basswood products are suitable for dying with natural/vegetable-based dyes.
